ABOUT ORGANIZATION

Manochetana is the registered (1998) Voluntary Service Organization working on the basis of "Not for Profit". It works for the Training and Rehabilitation of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities which are broadly grouped as Person with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (PWIDDs). In addition it also extends services the Persons with other Disabilities. Manochetana has continued its Services and Support since its inspection and successfully completed 18 years (1998-2016) of its Service Journey and added features into its Service Cap. During this Service Journey, Manochetana has gained Experience and Expertise to eater PWIDDs and other PWDs the needs of and conducted several Activities/Programmes during the year 2015-16 in addition to the regular projects situated both at Warangal and Cherial.

Manochetana works with specific Vision, Mission, Objecitves and Core Values and were furnished below as:

VISION: The quality of life of every Person with Disabilities and other vulnerable is equal to other citizens in community in that they live independently to the maximum extent possible.

MISSION: To work for needy people's empowerment with holistic development with special emphasis on children and women and to provide them with livelihood opportunities and bring them into the mainstream of the society. Through constant professional endeavors, empowers the Person with Disabilities to access the State-of-the-art rehabilitation, Intervention, leisure, social, sports, cultural and full participation for sustainable development with quality of life.

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GENESIS

The Philosophical social harmony transfer of a grandfather led for the conceptualization and development of Manochetana. The man behind this process is Chukka Venkateshwarlu, who started as a service provider leaving lucrative carrier both in India and at United States of America. He is a special educator and transformed several members to be with the community development. Manochetana got registered as nongovernmental organizational (NGO) in the year 1998 with a base at Warangal as headquarters and rural project at Cherial Mandal of Warangal district, Telangana.

OBJECTIVES

Based on the needs, skills and vulnerability of the people, the objectives of the organization are very specific and some such are as follows:

- To organize and provide for the disabled rehabilitation oriented pre-school & School education, vocational based training cum production, employment opportunities.
- Sheltered workshop, fabrication of artificial limbs and calipers.
- To assist in organizing seminars, conferences, trainings, meetings concerned with the disability & community development.
- To empower the disabled, working on their abilities, sharpen their capability.
- To assist the family, community to take responsibility of the disabled persons as contributing members of the society.
- To facilitate efforts for implementation of rights of the disabled, their policies etc.
- \circ To provide mobile health services in tribal and other areas.
- To develop awareness among the people regarding civic sense and social relationship.
- Other activities / programmes / services suiting to the vision and mission of the Organization.

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The details of the Projects, Activities, Programmes, and Celebrations organized during the year 2015-16 were briefly furnished below:

PROJECTS - COMPLETED:

Manochetna has successfully completed several projects since its inception and some of them include:

- > CBR Project supported by CAPART, New Delhi (2005 2007).
- ▶ RSTC supported by RVM (SSA), Warangal (2004 2012).
- School for Child Labour supported by NCLP, Warangal (2000 2003).
- National Programme on Education for Girls at Elementary Level (NPEGEL) supported by SSA, Warangal (2005-2006).
- Aspiration, an Early Intervention Scheme of the National Trust, under MSJ&E, Government of India, New Delhi (2009-2014).

PROJECTS – RUNNING

Manochetana has continued Projects on priority basis and the details of the Projects continued during the year 2015-16 were furnished below as:

1. EARLY INTERVENTION CENTRE (0-6 Years Age Group): This is situated at Cherial and providing Early Intervention Services covering: Early Identification, Screening & Assessment, Counseling & Guidance, Activities of Daily Livings (ADL's), Academics, Physio & other Therapeutics, Speech & Communication. Behaviour Modification. Fun Games. Recreation and Preparation for Mainstreaming into Normal Schools.





During the year, all such benefits were extended to **25** Beneficiaries. At all the stages Parents were motivated to involve in the Process at Institute, Home and Community. This Centre is partly supported by Social Welfare Department, Government of Telangana, Hyderabad.

2. **SPECIAL SCHOOL (6-18 Years Age Group)**: This is situated at Cherial and provided the Services of Special Education, ADL's, Therapeutics, Games & Cultural Activities, Prevocational Activities and other need based Services / Support matching to the needs and vulnerabilities of the Beneficiaries. Preparing the group for the Vocational Training is the essential part of this Project.

Under this Project, **110** beneficiaries have got the benefit with the participation of their Parents Siblings / Grandparents who have also got training both at Institute and Home to take care of their Child. This Project is partly supported by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India, New Delhi.



3. Vocational Training Centre (Above 18 Years): After the completion of Special Schooling, the PWDs were given Vocational Training / Skill Development in the selected Trades and many have got such benefit. This Project is supported bv Manochetana from its internal resources which are not regular in Nature and thus expects external support.



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4. **District Disability Rehabilitation Centre (DDRC):** This is situated at Warangal and supports all categories of PWDs with need based Services. This Centre is supported by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India, New Delhi.



Manochetana is the Implementing Organization (NGO) under the Guidance of District Collector & Magistrate of Warangal District, Government of Telangana.

5. Human Resource Development (HRD – D. Ed): The Centre is situated at Cherial. It has continued the Regular Course on Diploma in Education (Special Education in Mental Retardation) in collaboration with National Institute for the Empowerment of Multiple Disabilities (NIEPMD), under Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India, Chennai, Tamil Nadu and recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India, New Delhi.

The second batch has successfully completed its 2 years course and Third Batch has entered into Second Year. This is the one the rare opportunity to the NGOs to run such Course that to in Rural Area.

6. **Information Centre**: In the capacity of Organizational Member of the District Local Level Committee, Warangal of the National Trust, GOI, New Delhi continued and maintained this centre with effective dissemination & reached the groups.





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ACTIVITIES / PROGRAMMES / CELEBRATIONS: A brief details of the Activities / Programmes / Celebrations organized during the year 2015 – 2016 were furnished below as:

2nd April 2015 - Autism Awareness Day: Organized Celebrations by conducting a Rally Started by Shri. K. V. Ramana Chary, Municipal Commissioner, Siddipet Municipal Corporation. In this Children with Autism and their Parents have actively participated in creating awareness about the causes, consequences and early identification of Children with Autism among the Citizens.

in addition to the facilitation for benefits like: Pensions, Scholarships, Loans, Employment, Self Help Groups and other need based s supports, Manochetana has shown keen interest to mobilize and enroll the PWD's under NIRAMAYA Health Insurance Scheme of the National Trust, Governmetn of India, New Delhi. It is continuing all such process since last11 years in the capacity of Registered NGO of National Trust and Organization Members of the Local Level Committee (LLC) of Warangal District. During this year, the benefits of enrollment, renewal and facilitation for the utilization by the mode of reimbursement of expenditure incurred as per the Guidelines have been extended to the PWIDDs who are attending the Centre of Manochetana and staying at Communities.

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OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENTS OF MANOCHETANA

The need based with participatory strategies adopted by Manochetana have resulted for several achievements and credentials with significant impact in the lives of PWDs in terms of:

- 1. The reach of the targeted groups has been enhanced by 43%.
- 2. The awareness and orientation among the stakeholders resulted for the change in the attitudes with minimization of myths & barriers and further for improved access for services & benefits.
- 3. It has been actively involved in organizing medical camps, blood donation camps and rallies in showcasing their skills and abilities and further for minimizing myths & barriers in the community.
- 4. As an organizational member of LLC, Warangal Dist., improved the reach in respect of NT Act and its objectives, schemes, benefits and future vision.
- 5. The benefits of Niramaya have been extended to more than 2000 children which made Manochetana1st in state of Telangana. This has been recognized by Govt. by way of district award on the eve of January 2015.

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6. Development of human recourses by way of Foundation Course and Certificate Course in Care Giving (85 in 4 batches) covering parents, siblings, PWDs, house wives, volunteers and teachers resulted for the strengthening of professionals as well as inclusion of targeted groups both at schools and society.

7. The services of Aspiration Day Care Center were effective, participatory, and resulted for mainstreaming of **23** students into special school (**17**) and normal school (**5**).

8. The skills of children have been improved through its special school and prevocational activities for 135 students and to prepare some of them for the vocational training.

9. Skill Based Vocational Training in the area of Agro Based Vocational Training i.e. Nursery, Gardening, Cultivation as well office work, phenyl, washing powder, gardening, dairy, vegetable growing, tailoring & water purification unit has improved their employability. 5 trainers are employees of Manochetana, 13 got the support for the self-employment, 17 trainers are working with local establishments and others are supporting their family trades.

10. Networking and association with other government programmes has resulted for an effective mechanism of preventing disabilities and further to move towards Disability Free Society, the vision of Andhra Pradesh and medical supply & support.

11. It has supported for getting the disability certificate and pension for 5342 PWDs and 576 PWDs got Aids & Appliances.

12. The CBR channel has improved the reach covering 30 villages of 2 mandals and supported for better enrolment of PWDs during the recent Censes 2011 and the process has been continued to cast their vote with better access as a right.

13. Formation of 55 SHGs with the parents & children improved their empowerment both socially and economically.

14. It has provided counseling and carrier guidance to 82 employees / students to do courses either on regular or distance mode covering: Certificate / Diploma / Graduation / Post Graduation in Disability, Therapeutics, Community Development, Service Management and other related courses and most of them are directly or indirectly associated with disability rehabilitation.

15. Its active role in the district consultative meets on the new law / RPWD

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Act 2011 supported for better dissemination and feedback with suitable suggestions.

16. Its dedicated work has resulted for the recommendation by the Government for the establishment of DDRC in Warangal District.

17. The services of Manochetana have been recognized by way of 8 District Awards and stood leading NGO in Warangal District.

18. Actively worked with the Government scheme and obtained marriage incentive amounting Rs. 3000/- for 14 numbers of persons with disabilities who got married either with the normal or the persons with disabilities.

19. The networking with national and international disability institutions and having foreign experienced Founder and Principal in disability rehabilitation has strengthened Manochetana to move forward towards **"think globally and act locally".**

20. Its expertise and innovation including foreign experience has been well documented and disseminated at all levels including International level. To sum up, Manochetana could achieve the targets created significant impact in the reach and lives of the children with mental retardation, autism, cerebral palsy & multiple disabilities along with their family members and thus to lead for an independent living with sustainability and quality of life. It is looking forward with future plans suiting to the needs and demands of the Persons with Disabilities and community in which they are living with the motto of "INCLUSION" in right based environment.
